LIMA - SACRED VALLEY – MACHU PICCHU - CUSCO
(4 Days / 3 Nights)

MAY 2022

SUN 22 LIMA - CUSCO - SACRED VALLEY

(Meal Plan: none)

Around 11am you will be transferred to the airport to take your domestic flight to Cusco (air ticket is not included).

Welcome to Cusco, the capital of the Inca's empire. Let you impress by the culture, Inca's architecture, and customs of this impressive city. Upon your arrival you will be met by our local representative and transferred to your selected hotel in the Sacred Valley. On the way you will stop at Chinchero to join a local weaving family in their courtyard for an overview of the Andean weaving process. Chinchero is renowned for the production of textiles done on backstrap looms. You will watch as wool is carded, spun, and dyed and learn about the different techniques used to create belts, ponchos and shawls. Overnight in Sacred Valley.



MON 23 SACRED VALLEY - MACHU PICCHU – SACRED VALLEY

(Meal Plan: Breakfast)

Around 7:30am you will be transferred to Ollantaytambo train station and take the train service. The train ride takes you through the Sacred Valley of the Incas up to Machu Picchu. Upon arrival in Aguas Calientes, you will take the shuttle bus to the entrance of the citadel. During your guided tour you will experience the uniqueness of the location and the genius that went into its construction. The duration of your magical trip to one of the seven new wonders of the world will be 2.5 hours, after which you will make your way back out of the citadel with your guide. Afternoon at leisure to have lunch in a local restaurant (on your own).

At the proper time you should walk until Aguas Calientes train station to take the train service going back to Ollantaytambo. At your arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel in the Sacred Valley

TUE 24 SACRED VALLEY – CUSCO

(Meal Plan: Breakfast)

This morning, you will leave for Cusco city. En route, you will visit Sacsayhuaman Fortress, the largest and most magnificent work left by the Incas. The massive terrace walls are amongst the largest used in any building in the Americas. The meticulous precision of the rockwork sheds light on the mastery of the Inca stonemasons. Then, you go to Cusco city. Admire the most impressive example of how Inca and Hispanic cultures fused together at the Koricancha or Sun Temple. Just at walking distance you find the Cathedral dominating the north-east side of Cusco's main square. One of the most famous paintings and icons within is the 'Last Supper' by Quechua artist Marcos Zapata. The 18th century painting symbolizes the blend of indigenous and European cultures. Instead of a lamb on the table you find a guinea pig. Take then a cobblestoned street going up to the traditional artist's quarter of San Blas. Many of the best craftsmen have their workshops and small galleries in the cobbled, narrow streets. From the main square, take Triunfo Street to Hatunrumiyoc and see its famous twelve-sided stone. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Cusco.

(Meal Plan: Breakfast)

It is time to say goodbye to this marvelous city. At proper time, you will be transferred to the airport to take your departure flight (air ticket is not included). Back home with incredible memories to share with your loved ones.

MACHU PICCHU

- Entrance tickets to Machu Picchu are personalized and have to be pre-purchased with full passport details of the visitor. Once issued, these tickets are non-refundable and non-transferrable.
- Each ticket is issued for a specific timeslot, during which you have access to enter Machu Picchu. For each timeslot there is a limited number of tickets allocated, which are sold first come, first served.
- The visit to Machu Picchu is restricted to specific circuits which you'll need to follow. It is not possible to re-enter the ruins with the same entrance ticket.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Although it is not mandatory to have travel insurance, we recommend purchasing a travel insurance to protect against any emergency during the trip. This information must be sent before arrival.

PERURAIL BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE RESTRICTIONS

PeruRail has the following baggage allowance restrictions for passengers taking the train to Machu Picchu: Only 1 piece of hand luggage up to a maximum of 5 kg (11 pounds) and a total linear dimension of 157 cm (62 inches) per passenger is accepted. Visitors should be advised in advance about this regulation so that they can prepare their hand luggage in case of an overnight in Aguas Calientes/Machu Picchu or the Sacred Valley.

TAX ON SALES (VAT) IN CASE OF 'NO SHOW' IN PERU

Hotel rates for foreign travelers, nonresident in Peru, are exempted from the 18% VAT – as long as their stay in Peru is less than 60 days. In the event that a traveler does not use the reserved service(s) at the hotel ('no show') the amount invoiced by the hotel is subject to the additional payment of 18% tax on sales according to the Peruvian tax regulation. That means the tax exemption for foreign travelers is no longer valid in case of 'no show'.
