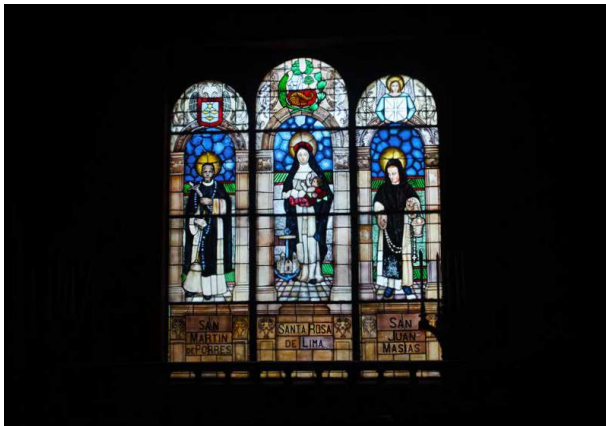

### **HISTORIC LIMA AND ITS CULTURE (City tour and Larco Herrera Museum)**

#### **Description:**

A shared sightseeing tour in Peru's capital Lima, an UNESCO World Heritage Site, will present you one of the country's finest Baroque buildings, the San Pedro Church, and the city's most visited church, San Francisco. Stroll around Plaza de Armas, learn what is so special about the Convent of Santo Domingo and walk to 'Puente de Piedra', Lima's oldest bridge crossing over Rimac River. Afterwards you head to one of the most traditional and historical districts of Lima, Pueblo Libre. After passing by the Municipal Palace, Plaza Bolivar and the Church Santa María Magdalena in Baroque style, founded almost 500 years ago, the 'Antigua Taberna Queirolo' awaits you. This emblematic 140 years old tavern, founded by the Queirolo family, originally from Italy, has become generation after generation a benchmark of the Peruvian wine and pisco industry. Being in this emblematic place you cannot miss a 'pisco sour' demonstration or its traditional 'res de pisco' accompanied by a delicious 'butifarra', a typical sandwich with ham.

And then off to one of the best 25 museums in the world, the Larco Herrera Museum. The collection shows 3000 years of the Peruvian pre-Columbian history in an intuitive way. Its masterpieces are considered worldwide icons of pre-Inca art and have been displayed in the world's most renowned museums.

Your sightseeing tour explores the modern districts of Lima and its historic center, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1988. As

you wander the main plaza and Plaza San Martin it is hard not to wonder about its diverse architecture. Your guide will introduce you to the city's architectural heritage. You then proceed to Santo Domingo Monastery boasting fine carved choir stalls, the oldest of Lima. It was here that San Marcos University, the first in South America, was founded in 1551. Your next stop is at the Larco Herrera Museum. The collection allows the understanding of 3,000 years of the Peruvian pre-Columbian history in an intuitive way. Its masterpieces are considered worldwide icons of pre-Inca art and have been displayed in the world's most renowned museums.
